Dear All Saints

There's a big shift going on in the western church as we face up to the often scary realities of change that must happen if we are to be the kind of difference in the world that Jesus expects us to be. At the heart of that shift is the rediscovering of a more Biblical identity and purpose as resident aliens; a people of exile who don't belong here, but have been assigned here by a God who is heaven-bent on redeeming all He created good, not least each and every one of his dearly beloved children.

It was exciting for me to participate in the first 2020 Vision Group session with Bishop John and others that have been invited to work with him as he seeks to lead us a Diocese through this transition. At the heart of our conversation was a recognition that in all our church business and busyness, Jesus so easily gets squeezed out. Buildings, budgets, gatherings and groups, worship and work, are all good, but at the heart of
