## **Safeguarding Policy**

The following policy has been agreed and implemented by the PCC. We are committed to:

- The care, nurture of, and respectful pastoral ministry with, all children, young people and all adults;
- The safeguarding and protection of all children, young people and all adults;
- The establishing of safe, caring communities which provide a loving environment where victims
  of abuse can report or disclose abuse and where they can find support and best practice that
  contributes to the prevention of abuse.

## To this end:

- All Saints Worcester will adhere to the Church of England safeguarding policies to carefully select, support and train all those with any responsibility within the Church in line with the principles of 'Safer Recruitment', 'Protecting All God's Children', 'Promoting a Safer Church' and Domestic Abuse Policy Statement. - 2. The Safer Recruitment process will ensure that lay ministers, volunteers and paid workers who work with children and vulnerable adults are carefully selected and trained using the safer recruitment process and Disclosure and Barring Service to check the background of each person as outlined in the diocesan procedures. The Diocese will do likewise in respect of the ordained.
- 3. We will respond without delay to every complaint made, that any adult, child or young person may have been harmed, cooperating with the police and local authority in any investigation.
- 4. We will seek to offer informed pastoral care and support to anyone who has suffered abuse, developing with them an appropriate ministry that recognises the importance of understanding the needs of those who have been abused, including their feelings of alienation and / or isolation.
- 5. We will seek to protect survivors of abuse from the possibility of further harm and abuse.
- 6. We will seek to challenge any abuse of power, especially by anyone in a position of respect and responsibility, where they are trusted by others.
- 7. We will seek to offer pastoral care and support, including ensuring appropriate ongoing supervision, and referral to the appropriate authorities, to any member of our church community known to have offended against a child, young person or adult who is vulnerable.

- 8. We will review this policy annually, checking that all our procedures and activities involving children and vulnerable adults are up to date including the Disclosure and Barring Checks.
- 9. A copy of this Policy will be displayed on the Parish Notice Boards, alongside a Childline poster.
